Senator George Maziarz (R-C, Newfane) has been presented with the first-ever Mary Lucariello Legislative Award from the Western New York Youth Bureau Association. The award was announced at the Association's Presentation and Awards Breakfast held at Woodlawn Beach Lodge in Blasdell this morning.

"I am truly honored to receive this award," Senator Maziarz said.
