This year's Family Health & Fitness Fair will offer flu shots for the upcoming cold and flu season. The shots will be provided by the University of Rochester Medical Center Flu Prevention Program. Although most local insurance providers are accepted, visitors are reminded to bring their insurance cards.

Attendees of the Fair will find a wide variety of free services offered by area health providers. In addition to flu shots, the Family Health & Fitness Fair will provide individuals with screenings and testings for high blood pressure, glucose, cholesterol, and hearing, and much, much more. Those professionals and visitors that attend the Family Health & Fitness Fair will also have the opportunity to participate in a number of educational seminars, presented free-of-charge by local physicians and health care professionals.

Senator Alesi will also be accepting tattered American Flags at the Health Fair. Residents are welcome to drop-off their worn American Flags for proper disposal at this event.
