Donated phones will be sent to ReCellular, which pays Cell Phones for Soldiers for each phone – enough to provide an hour of talk time to soldiers abroad. About half of the phones ReCellular processes are reconditioned and resold to wholesale companies in countries around the world. Phones and components that cannot be refurbished are dismantled and recycled to reclaim materials, including gold, silver and platinum from circuit boards; copper wiring from phone chargers; nickel, iron, cadmium and lead from battery packs; and plastic from phone cases and accessories.

Cell Phones for Soldiers was founded by teenagers Robbie and Brittany Bergquist from Norwell, Mass. In 2004, with \$21 of their own money. Since then, the registered 501c3 non-profit organization has raised more than \$7 million in donations, recycled more than 8.3 million cell phones, and distributed more than 2 million prepaid calling cards to soldiers serving overseas, equating to 114 million minutes of free talk time.

Through increased fundraising efforts, the Bergquist family hopes to raise additional funds to support new programs, such as providing phones with prepaid service to allow soldiers abroad to talk to their families on a regular basis.
