Elmira, N.Y., January 6—To help kick off the new year in New York State government, which officially got underway Wednesday in Albany with Governor Andrew Cuomo's second State of the State message, Senator Tom O'Mara (R-C, Big Flats) today announced 2012 contact information for his district offices in Elmira and Bath, and his Albany office.
