

## Senator Fuschillo Announces Senate Confirmation of New Mta Chairman

Mr. Lhota's background includes serving as Deputy Mayor for Operations under Mayor Rudolph Giuliani, and also serving as Budget Director, where he was responsible for managing the City's multi-billion dollar operating and capital budgets. He is also a former Commissioner of the New York City Department of Finance. Mr. Lhota, who holds an MBA from Harvard University, also has extensive private sector experience.

Prior to his confirmation by the Senate, Mr. Lhota's qualifications and professional experience were examined as part of a Senate Transportation Committee meeting chaired by Senator Fuschillo.
