"The more informed we are about how we can prepare for an emergency, the safer we will be," said Serrano. "This requires a concerted effort, by families and communities working together to ensure relief in the aftermath of stressful situations. I would like to thank the American Red Cross in Greater New York for designing a plan that includes preparing a To Go Bag- containing essential food items and supplies, identifying a meeting place near your home as well as outside of your neighborhood, planning for the needs of seniors and people with disabilities, and making sure you have a designated friend or relative to call if your phone lines are down. These simple, yet effective steps, can make a life saving difference in the event of an emergency."
