Senator Fuschillo Statement on Thruway Toll Increase Proposal

ISSUE: TRANSPORTATION

"Earlier today, the New York State Thruway Authority Board voted to begin the process to implement a 45 percent increase on certain commercial tolls. They should reconsider their decision based on the economic impact it will have on New York's businesses and families.

A 45 percent toll increase would dramatically raise costs on trucking companies that are transporting goods across the state. While this is characterized a commercial toll increase, businesses will not be the only ones affected. Ultimately, consumers will pay for these cost increases in the form of higher prices on all types of goods.

The current economy is causing serious pain to families and businesses across the state. Many are barely surviving and can't afford to keep paying higher costs.

I urge the Thruway Authority to put the brakes on this toll increase and continue to find savings internally through improved efficiencies as a way to improve its finances."
