Members of the Wantagh American Legion Bagpipe Band led in a color guard composed of girl scouts from the Girl Scouts of Nassau County, which was followed by the pledge of allegiance and the singing of the "Star Spangled Banner" by Freeport resident Joseph Smith. Senator Fuschillo then showed a short tribute video thanking them for their service to our country. Congressman Peter King (R-Seaford) served as the event's guest speaker.

Senator Fuschillo also gave special recognition to Marine Corps Corporal Kevin Vaughan of North Merrick, who was recently named to the New York State Senate's Veterans Hall of Fame by Senator Fuschillo. Corporal Vaughan, a decorated combat veteran, served two tours of duty in Afghanistan and received the Purple Heart after being wounded in action.
