...Provide homeowners with information on available federal programs.

...Answer homeowner inquiries about the foreclosure process in New York State.

...Assist homeowners in efforts to obtain loan modifications and other forms of relief.

...Take complaints from aggrieved homeowners seeking resolution with banks and mortgage servicers.

Homeowners should bring all relevant information to document their personal situations, such as records of mortgage payments, correspondence from lenders and foreclosure notices.
