Senator Marty Golden stated, "As the Christmas season winds down, what better way to dispose of your Christmas tree than by giving the environment of New York City a present. Last year, many local residents participated, as it makes you feel good knowing that the tree is not just going to end up in the garbage."

The wood chips are used by the City to nourish trees and plants, or you can take home your very own bag of mulch to use in your garden.
