Senator Fuschillo has arranged for the Department of Financial Services' Mobile Assistance Unit to be at The Riviera, located at 200 East Shore Drive in Massapequa, on Friday, January 25th from 10 am to 6 pm.

Department of Financial Services representatives will be available to meet one-on-one with residents and answer storm-related questions about homeowners', renters', and business owners' insurance coverage. No appointments are necessary.
