Albany, N.Y., January 29—State Senator Tom O'Mara (R-C, Big Flats), a new member of the Senate Finance Committee which this week began a series of public hearings on Governor Andrew Cuomo's 2013-14 proposed state budget, has launched an online "2013 Economic & Fiscal Survey" that invites area residents to share their views on several of the key economic and fiscal challenges facing New York this year.

The second-term state senator said the new online survey offers an opportunity for local constituents to share their own views and suggestions on this year's state budget.
