In January 2013, the Ken-Ton Parent Association (KTPA) founded a program known as the Ken-Ton Closet.

This initiative organizes the collection of clothing (new and gently used), toiletries and [school supply](#) donations and distributes them for no cost to the children living with Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda. Donations are not tax-deductible at this time and the Closet does not accept cash donations.
