



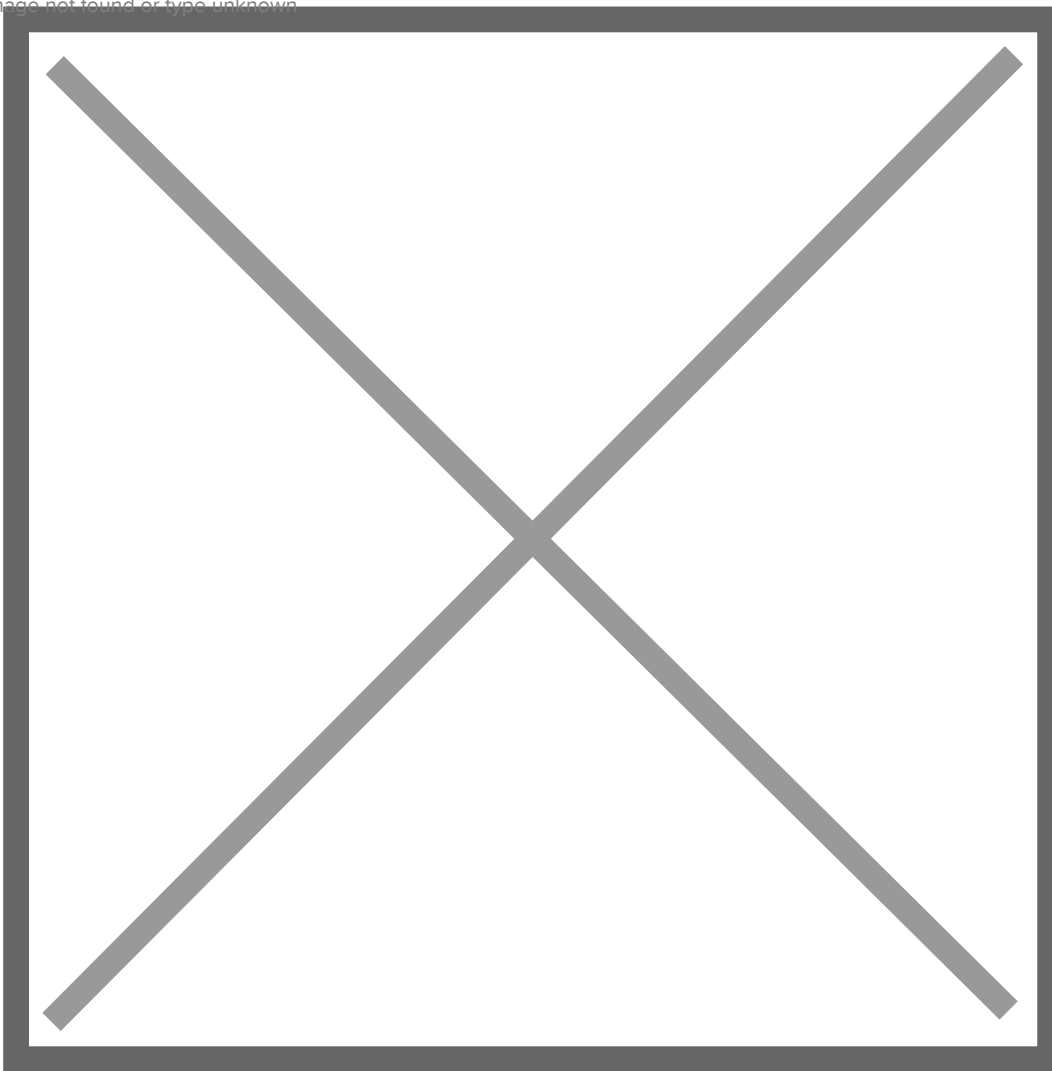

SENATOR TERRY GIPSON SECURES \$6 MILLION FOR BEACON REDEVELOPMENT

Poughkeepsie, NY – Senator Terry Gipson has secured \$6 million in redevelopment funds for the Beacon Correctional Facility.
