


Senator Boyle Honors Woman Of Distinction Jennifer Mackie Of Lindenhurst

Lindenhurst Resident Honored for Contributions to Community

ALBANY, NEW YORK – Senator Phil Boyle honored Lindenhurst resident Jennifer Mackie as part of the New York State Senate's 16th Annual Women of Distinction ceremony on May 7, 2013. Mackie, a mother of three sons who works as an Applied Behavior Analysis Therapist

with autistic children, was nominated by local residents to receive special recognition by the State Senate as a New York "Woman of Distinction" for her outstanding contributions to her community.

In the wake of Superstorm Sandy, Mackie created a non-profit organization called "Adopt a House" to help provide support for area residents who have been affected by unfortunate circumstances.
