Senator Golden Comments on the B 37 Bus Route

Brooklyn – State Senator Martin J. Golden (R-C-I, Brooklyn) today has issued the following statement regarding the B 37 bus route:

"I am very encouraged to learn that at next week's MTA Board Meeting, the restoration of the B 37 bus route will be among the agenda items. Since it was taken out of service in June 2010, I have never given up the fight, and the hope, that we will again see buses rolling along 3rd Avenue. I will continue to work with my colleagues in government, and with Metropolitan Transit Authority officials, to improve both local and express bus service."

Senator Golden filed a lawsuit against the Metropolitan Transit Authority in the wake of the termination of the B 37 bus route. The lawsuit cited the community needs for such service due to and the lack of elevator friendly subway stations, that prevent handicapped and seniors from traveling in Brooklyn.
