At both programs, parents will be able to bring their children, along with the children's bikes and helmets to receive:

- Safety training on a bicycle obstacle course
- Free bike, helmet, brake and tire safety checks
- Information on New York state bicycle & helmet laws
- Instructions on how to use hand signals
- Instructions on sharing the road with cars and pedestrians.

Trained representatives from the New York Coalition for Transportation Safety will provide the safety training and conduct the bicycle obstacle course.
