- Free flu & pneumonia vaccinations (provided by NuHealth for residents ages 60 and over, subject to availability);
- Free blood pressure, hearing, and chiropractic screenings;
- Mammography screenings (requires an appointment – call Senator Fuschillo's office for more information);

- Obtain or renew a passport (call Senator Fuschillo's office for information about requirements);

- Review and learn about medication interaction with a pharmacist (bring a list of medications, vitamins, and supplements being taken).

"The Golden Gathering offers a wide variety of programs, services, and information all in one convenient location. I invite all residents to attend this year's Golden Gathering and take advantage of these services," said Senator Fuschillo.

The Towns of Hempstead, Oyster Bay and Babylon, as well as the Village of Massapequa Park, will be providing free transportation for seniors from 10 different locations.
