That is why Senator Boyle is hosting two "Shed the Meds" events on Saturday, June 7th and Saturday, July 12th.

In conjunction with the Suffolk County Sheriff's Department, Senator Boyle will be collecting medications for safe disposal. "By properly disposing of household prescription drugs, we can help to keep them out of the wrong hands," said Senator Phil Boyle. "By doing so, we also keep harmful materials from damaging our local waterways and water supply," he continued.
