A LIRR strike would be a disaster, would paralyze Long Island’s transportation infrastructure and cause up to \$50 million in economic losses a day. Every Long Islander will be impacted, whether they commute or not. I thank the Governor for listening.

This is a positive step, but we are not out of the woods yet. I hope the Governor will continue his efforts personally to help both sides break the logjam and reach an agreement, before a strike occurs.”
