Over 150 seniors received a free wallet-sized ID card which includes their name, personal information (name, address, phone number, date of birth), and an emergency contact name and phone number which could be useful to emergency responders. Seniors can carry the

card in their wallet so that first responders will know who to contact if the senior is in an emergency situation and cannot communicate.
