

Ritchie Secures \$50,000 to Help Fund Rebuild of Clayton's "Wooden Castle Playground"

State Senator Patty Ritchie has announced she has secured \$50,000 in special funding to help the Village of Clayton offset the costs associated with a playground being rebuilt in the Village.

"This funding not only will help the municipality manage costs associated with improving the park, it will also give residents and visitors a new and improved family-friendly way to spend their time."

This past spring, a major phase of the rebuilding of the park—also known as the "Wooden Castle Playground"—was completed thanks to donations from the community as well as volunteer labor provided by Fort Drum soldiers.
