Monies to go towards continued repairs to Town Hall's front porch

Senator John Bonacic (R/C/I – Mt. Hope) announces that the Town of Liberty has been awarded \$50,000 in funding from the State & Municipal Facilities Capital Program.

The project details call for continued improvements to the front porch of Town Hall including the architectural pillars, guard rail and new roof of the front porch in order to preserve the building's historic value.

"We have asked for funds for this beautiful old building which has served the town well since the 1970's," said Supervisor Charles Barbuti. "Restoring the front porch would help preserve our bit of history, and allow the building to be used for years to come.
