### **It Is Not Important Which Diaz The Governor Mentioned**

You should know that the name Ruben Diaz was once again pronounced by New York State Governor Andrew Cuomo during the State of the State Address on Wednesday, January 21, 2015.

Before more than 3,000 people, including many dignitaries, television cameras and reporters who attended the State of the State, the Governor, while announcing his transportation development plans for Bronx County stated: "We want to build 4 MTA stations in the Bronx, to open up that side of the Bronx."
