- · Basic STAR
- · Enhanced STAR
- · Senior Citizens
- · Veterans and Cold War Veterans
- · Volunteer Firefighters and Ambulance Workers
- · Limited Income Disability

· Home Improvement

Applications will be processed by the Department on-site. Homeowners who will be filing for an exemption should bring two copies of any documentation that is required for the property tax exemption, including proof of age, proof of residency and 2014 New York State and federal income tax returns.
