

Testimony from April 30 public hearing of New York State's business taxes

ISSUE: FINANCE

On April 30, 2009, the Select Committee on Budget and Tax Reform held a public hearing in Rochester to weigh the fairness of New York State's Corporate Franchise Tax and the effectivess of its tax expenditures.
