Resolution: (ADAMS, Leibell) Paying just tribute and remembering the fifty-nine (59) brave members of the United States Armed forces who are from, have family ties to, or were stationed in New York, and who lost their lives during 2009 while fighting on behalf of the United States and the State of New York 1/26/10

Bills:

S. 139 Sampson

Exempts veterans of World War II from any additional fees when they order license plates stating "World War II Veteran".

S. 1883 Klein

Exempts veterans organizations in New York city, as defined in section 452 of the real property tax law, from payment of city sewer and water charges.

S. 3815 Adams

Authorizes forty days or thirty working days of military leave for state correction officers who are absent on military duty; such leave to be in addition to any leave authorized for such correction officers in their state contract.

S.4876A Foley

Relates to prorating a veteran's exemption if such veteran moves within the same county.

Note- All bills and nominations moved through committee.
