- **Personal Flotation Devices:** Ensure that your boat is equipped with the proper USCG life jacket (s).
- **Speed:** In NYS, boat speed is generally limited to 5 mph when within 100 feet of shore, dock, pier, raft, float or anchored boat. Check with local officials for local regulations.
- **Sound Signals:** Familiarize yourself with the various sound signals for passing other boats at close quarters.
