The previously unnamed bridge, referred to as the "Center Street Bridge" was newly named after the famed Seneca statesman Chief Cornplanter.

The new bridge includes areas for pedestrians, bicyclists and large vehicles. It also includes a

fishing platform, landscaping, lighting, and sidewalks.
