

Albany, N.Y., March 5—State Senator Tom O'Mara (R-C, Big Flats), a member of the Senate Agriculture Committee, and his Senate Republican colleagues today unveiled "Jobs & Progress--Grown in New York," a comprehensive economic development strategy for agriculture that they believe can help keep New York State's leading industry competitive for the next generation. "We need to keep taking actions that keep our farmers competitive for the long haul. We can't risk New York State's farmers being taxed, regulated and priced out of business.
