Senator Stewart-Cousins broke ground at Regeneron Pharmaceuticals, kicking off the expansion project of the company's corporate headquarters and laboratories in Westchester County. New York State contributed \$8.5 million in tax credits through the Excelsior Jobs Program to make this expansion possible.

The expansion will add two new buildings of lab and office space to the Regeneron Complex at the Landmark of Eastview and enable the company to accommodate the rapid growth it has experienced over the last six years. It will also create more than 400 new high-skill jobs in
