Funding to Repair Meachem Ice Rink

I was pleased to secure \$350,000 in state capital funds to help pay for repairs to the Meachem ice rink in the valley section of Syracuse, which closed earlier this year due to malfunctions in the ice cooling system. I heard first hand from elected officials, parents, hockey league organizers, and skaters just how important the Meachem rink is to those who call it their home ice.

The funding will go to purchase an ice mat, which will form a rink when laid on a concrete floor. The refrigerant runs through the mat chilling when water is put on top of the sheet. The money will also purchase compressors which feed refrigerant through the mat and dehumidifiers for the rink. It is expected the rink will be reopened in time for the beginning of the next hockey season in October.
