Mayor de Blasio signed the bill reducing the city speed limit to 25 mph. The reduced limit, a portion of the larger Vision Zero policy to reduce New York traffic related fatalities, will go into effect November 7. Earlier this year [Senator Dilan joined advocates](#) in the push to lower city speed limits after the year began with reckless driving claiming a victim a day. After [sponsoring several measures](#) to give the city the ability to lower the limit, the bill passed the legislature and was signed into law by Gov. Cuomo this summer.
