STREET CLOSURES AND TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

Central Park

Friday, September 25, 5:00pm—7:00pm

- Pope Francis' Central Park Procession begins at approximately 5:00 PM and concludes at 7:00PM on Friday, September 25th.
- 12:00 AM to 7:00 PM
 - Streets will be closed to vehicular traffic on 61st Street, 62nd Street, 63rd Street, 64th Street, 65th Street and 66th Street between Central Park West and Broadway.
 - Streets will be closed to vehicular traffic on 67th Street, 68th Street, 69th Street, 70th Street, 71st Street, 72nd Street, 73rd Street, 74th Street, 75th Street, 76th Street and 77th Street.
