(New York City - October 8th) Climate change is a real concern that New York State is taking the lead on. Senator Stewart-Cousins, the Senate Democratic Leader, joined Governor Cuomo and former Vice President Al Gore as they signed a pledge to combat climate change and reduce greenhouse gas emissions in New York State. The Governor announced he will sign the Under 2 Memorandum of Understanding, which commits New York State to a global effort to keep the earth's average temperature from rising two degrees Celsius from the pre-industrial level benchmark.
