Women who receive early screening, diagnosis and treatment have an increased chance of survival.

Screenings are available to women 40 and older who have not had a mammogram in the past year. All insurance plans are accepted and co-payments and deductibles are waived. An appointment is necessary and can be made by calling 1-800-564-6868.
