Others made suggestions for expanding involvement in the Indo-Caribbean community. Sanders' staffers took careful notes and filled out constituent intake forms so they could examine specific issues in greater detail and follow-up with extended help.

Richmond Hill Community Day is part of Senator Sanders' mobile office initiative, which aims to reach more constituents and make it easier for them to access services. It will travel to different areas of the senator's district on a rotating basis.
