

## READ ON! RITCHIE ANNOUNCES \$14,500 TO SUPPORT LITERACY PROGRAMS IN NORTH COUNTRY SCHOOL DISTRICTS

In an effort to improve student reading skills, State Senator Patty Ritchie has announced \$14,500 in special funding to support reading programs in school districts throughout Jefferson and St. Lawrence Counties.

"When we enhance student reading skills, we improve their ability to learn, grow and imagine," said Senator Ritchie.

"Learning to read is the foundation of a student's education, and I'm so pleased to provide this funding, which will help to expand learning opportunities for children across our region."
