WHEREAS, A true leader, Gary Fahey was promoted to Oneida Facility

Branch Director in 2005, and just three years later was named Vice President of Membership and Program Services as well as Vice President of Development; and

WHEREAS, In 2013, Gary Fahey earned the title of Rome Family YMCA Executive Director, the esteemed position from which he is retiring; and

WHEREAS, Truly carrying the mission of the YMCA in his heart, Gary Fahey has shown a steadfast and unremitting commitment to this vital organization for 35 years, and has touched the lives of countless individuals; and
