WHEREAS, Attendant to such concern, and in full accord with its long-standing traditions, this Legislative Body is justly proud to commend Liz Benjamin and Jasmine Shea upon the occasion of their designation for special recognition by Upper Hudson Planned Parenthood at its Roe V. Wade Celebration to be held on Friday, February 12, 2016, at the Renaissance Albany Hotel in Albany, New York; and

WHEREAS, Individuals who give of their time and energies and serve the best interests of their communities are an asset beyond remuneration and cannot be sufficiently extolled; and

WHEREAS, For more than 15 years, Liz Benjamin has been a strong investigative reporter asking the tough questions and breaking news in print and online; as the host of "Capital Tonight", she has shined the light on issues which affect everyone in her community and throughout the State; and

WHEREAS, Jasmine Shea is being honored by Planned Parenthood Advocates of New York, Upper Hudson Chapter, with the 2016 Sarah Weddington Award for Youth Leadership for her tireless work and commitment to reproductive rights; and

WHEREAS, The viral campaign around the Hobby Lobby issue, the Saturday one-woman counter protests and the PinkOUT event, highlight Jasmine Shea's unique and energetic commitment to the cause of women and reproductive freedom; and

WHEREAS, Throughout the entire period of their service, a period of constructive involvement, Liz Benjamin and Jasmine Shea have stood constant in dignity, good grace and humor; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that when individuals of such noble aims and accomplishments are brought to our attention, they should be celebrated and recognized by all the citizens of the great State of New York; now, therefore, be it
