As part of Advocacy Day in Albany, Senator Ortt spoke at a Friends of Recovery-New York (FOR-NY) rally for hundreds of people who have been influenced by drugs and alcohol. FOR-NY was urging lawmakers to consider spending \$50 million in programs for people struggling with addiction.
