Saratoga CART consists of representatives from Agriculture and Markets; Cooperative Extension; Saratoga County Public Health; USDA Farm Service; the Saratoga County Animal Shelter; Saratoga County Emergency Services; local veterinarians and valued volunteers. The important mission of Saratoga CART is: “To protect livestock, domesticated animals including companion animals, the public health, the environment and to ensure the humane care and treatment of animals in case of a large scale natural, man-made or technological emergency or other situations that cause animal suffering.”
