Have you ever thought about serving your community as a volunteer firefighter? If so, then you'll definitely want to visit a participating local fire company during "RecruitNY Weekend" this coming Saturday, April 23, and Sunday, April 24. Sponsored by the Firemen's Association of the State of New York (FASNY), RecruitNY Weekend is a recruitment and retention initiative that highlights the need and benefits of becoming a volunteer firefighter. During RecruitNY Weekend, volunteer departments across the State open their doors and invite the community in. As part of RecruitNY, open houses will provide information about the membership process, available free training programs, responsibilities and what a typical day-in-the-life of a volunteer firefighter involves. Individuals will also learn about some of the benefits they can receive from volunteering, like tax breaks offered by the state and some local communities.

I secured \$250,000 as part of the 2016-17 State Budget to support the recruitment and retention of local volunteer firefighters to help promote public safety and protect local communities.
