WHEREAS, A gifted scorer and talented young athlete, Kelsey Minato established a new West Point Academy and Patriot League career scoring record of 2,556 points, and was ranked seventh in the Nation at 23.2 points per game; she also owns all-time West Point career marks for 3-pointers (329), free throws (569) and field goals (829); and WHEREAS, In addition, this esteemed athlete has helped lead her Army Black Knights Basketball Team to an impressive record of 29 wins with

just three losses, a 17-0 record at home, and three Patriot League tournament wins by an average of 25 points, as well as an NCAA tournament berth; and

WHEREAS, The recipient of numerous awards and honors, Kelsey Minato has earned All-American honors and was a first-team All-Metropolitan pick the past three seasons and second-team as a freshman; she has also won the Patriot League MVP award three times; and

WHEREAS, Kelsey Minato's overall basketball career has been outstanding, and she was loyally and enthusiastically supported by family, fans, friends and the community at large; and

WHEREAS, Sports competition instills the values of teamwork, pride and accomplishment, and Kelsey Minato has clearly made a contribution to the spirit of excellence which is a tradition of her school; now, therefore, be it
