Thirty-six individuals from throughout Central and Northern New York were honored Thursday for their contributions to their country and their communities at a special New York State Senate "Veterans Hall of Fame" ceremony hosted by State Senator Patty Ritchie.

"This year's Veterans Hall of Fame honorees represent such a diverse range of service—including Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, as well as nearly every significant theater from WWII Europe and the Pacific to Iraq and Afghanistan," said Senator Ritchie.
