Halfmoon, NY – In commemoration of the 50th Anniversary of the Vietnam War, Senator Kathy Marchione (R,C,I-Halfmoon), Chair of the Senate Local Government Committee, and member of the Senate Veterans, Homeland Security and Military Affairs Committee, is **sponsoring The Vietnam Memorial Moving Wall when it visits the Halfmoon Town Park next week,**

A half-size replica of the Washington, D.C. What: The Vietnam Memorial Moving Wall visits Halfmoon to honor the sacrifice of America's Vietnam Veterans who made the ultimate sacrifice

When: Next week, Thursday, June 2, through Monday, June 6. Hours for The Moving Wall:

Thursday, June 2: 1 p.m. to 10 p.m., Opening Ceremony at 2 p.m.

Friday, June 3: 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Saturday, June 4: 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Sunday, June 5: 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Monday, June 6: 7 a.m. to noon, Closing Ceremony at 11 a.m.

For the duration of The Moving Wall's visit to Halfmoon next week, June 2-6, every morning a military veteran bugler will begin the day's commemoration, and a bagpiper will play every night to close. The Moving Wall will feature hundreds of local volunteers reading aloud the names of the Vietnam War's fallen. Volunteer readers will read in increments with a duration of approximately 15 minutes for each volunteer; approximately 300 volunteers are taking part in this important community effort that honors America's Vietnam Veterans
