More than 50 employers were on hand Thursday to meet with those looking for work at State Senator Patty Ritchie's annual St. Lawrence County Job Fair.

Held at the Richard G. Lockwood Civic Center in Ogdensburg, the event is the second of two events hosted by Senator Ritchie to connect job-seekers with local employers. Since 2012, nearly 2,500 people have attended the annual events.
