School districts receiving funding include the following:

• Massena Central School District: \$4,000 for the purchase of new football uniforms

• Canton Central School District: \$7,000 for the purchase of new girls and boys basketball uniforms
• Morristown Central School District: \$5,000 for uniforms
• Sackets Harbor Central School District: \$5,000 for the purchase of fitness equipment
