ISSUE: SENATE COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENTS, RULES

State Senator Joseph Griffo today announced that he has been named to the **Senate Rules**Committee, an influential committee in determining the flow of legislation in Albany.

Senator Griffo, R-Rome, is already serving on the other most significant legislative committee, the **Senate Finance Committee**, which reviews any legislation that requires the expenditure of state funds.

Senator Griffo has also been appointed to the **Senate Transportation Committee**, and will continue to serve as chairman of the **Senate Energy and Telecommunications Committee** as well as the **Senate Select Committee on State-Native American Relations**.

The other committees Senator Griffo will continue to serve as a member include: Codes; Commerce, Economic Development and Small Business; Crime Victims, Crime and Corrections; Higher Education; and Racing, Wagering and Gaming.
