The mission of OBT is to help disadvantaged youth and adults recognize their own self-worth, and advance towards self-sufficiency and financial security through job training, academic reinforcement, improved life skills, job placement, and support services. Opportunities for a Better Tomorrow is the largest provider of job training services for 17-24 year olds who are not working and not in school, the majority of whom do not have a High School Diploma.
